### ERG continues to grow in France: Limousin I Wind Farm started up

**Genoa, 24 July 2024** – ERG has completed the construction and initiated the energization of the Saint-Maurice-la-Clouère windfarm, in the Vienne department, in Nouvelle-Aquitaine.

The wind farm, which benefits from a tariff regime with a 20-year CfD, consists of four Vestas V100 turbines of 2.2 MW each, for a total capacity of 9 MW and an estimated annual production of 19 GWh, which is equivalent to the energy needs of about 3,000 households.

The Limousin I wind farm, the first of three plants currently under construction in France for a total of 60 MW, represents a step forward in ERG's organic growth abroad and is also a concrete example of the Group's commitment to ESG, particularly in preserving biodiversity. The planning of the construction schedule has indeed considered the nesting periods of the local wildlife, and regarding the landscape, new hedgerows and shrubs will be planted along the perimeter of the farm.
