### **TIM AND ERG LAUNCH THE “MISSION ENVIRONMENT-GENERATIONS AT SUSTAINABILITY SCHOOL” PROJECT**

*The TIM and ERG Academy project kicked off today in Benevento with the aim of contributing to spread the culture of sustainability*

*The project will involve ten Italian cities and includes in-depth courses on sustainability, environmental protection and ecological transition for secondary school students*

The "Mission Environment - Generations at sustainability school" project kicked off today from the Bosco Lucarelli School in Benevento, launched by **TIM** and **ERG**, through **ERG Academy**, on a national scale and aimed at raising awareness on issues of environmental sustainability.

The project, which will involve 10 Italian cities, includes specific in-depth sessions on sustainability, environmental protection and ecological transition for each stage, which will see the students acting as protagonists.

In fact, the project is included in the path for transversal skills and orientation (PCTO) of upper secondary schools, which has inherited the purposes of the former school-work alternation, and has the objective of contributing to the **diffusion of the culture of sustainability**, with a particular focus on the preservation and protection of our planet. The meetings, whose ambition is to promote a horizontal and collaborative model, provide ample space for debate between business experts and participants from the schools involved in order to encourage exchange and dialogue between the different generations.

The inaugural event in Benevento was attended by TIM's **Andrea Ferrazzi**, a former senator of the Republic and coordinator of the work for the amendments to Articles 9 and 41 of the Constitution (extension of the protection of the landscape, environment, biodiversity, ecosystems in the interest of future generations), and ERG's **Alessandro De Vita**, Permitting Specialist and **Gianluca Gramegna** Head of ESG. **Cristina Sivieri Tagliabue**, founder and director of the online newspaper La Svolta, the project's media partner, moderated the speeches.

The project's organisational partner is **ELIS**, a non-profit educational organisation that has always been active in the world of schools with various activities supporting the growth and orientation of students.

The tour, which started today from Benevento, is scheduled for Foggia (25 January), Catania (1 February), Catanzaro (21 February), Cagliari (6 March), Arezzo (20 March), Modena (10 April), Ascoli Piceno (18 April), Genoa (9 May) and will end in Venice on 16 May.

*TIM, a leading group in the ICT sector in Italy and Brazil, through its subsidiary Telenergia, and ERG, a primary independent producer of renewable energy, through its subsidiary ERG Power Generation, have signed a nine-year agreement for the supply of approximately 200 GWh/year (Gigawatt hours) of green energy for the period 2023-2031. The contract provides for the integration of the PPA (Power Purchase Agreement) previously signed on 14 May 2021 for the supply of 340 GWh/year for 10 years, with an additional volume of 200 GWh per year "baseload" of 100% green energy produced by renewable plants in the ERG portfolio, and the updating of the related commercial terms. Through this agreement, TIM will cover approximately 34% of its purchases of*

renewable energy through PPAs, strengthening its commitment to pursuing the objectives of using 100% green energy by 2025 and reducing CO2 emissions on which the Group's strategy is based. For ERG this agreement represents an important result consistent with the strategic objective of securing 85-90% of its EBITDA, as envisaged in the Group's 2022-2026 Business Plan.
