ERG continues to develop organically in Germany

Three public auctions awarded for 40 MW of new wind capacity Construction of the first Repowering project completed

Genoa, 28 March 2025 - ERG announces that it has won three single-price auctions granting it twenty-year tariffs for the construction and operation of the Heyen, Jeggeleben and Brunsbuttel wind farms, totalling 40 MW. The projects - one *greenfield* and two involving the *repowering* of existing plants, respectively - will enter into operation between 2026 and 2027, for an estimated total production of 85 GWh per year.

The development of the Group's asset portfolio in Germany also continues with the completion of the 6 MW *repowering* of the Reinsdorf wind farm, with expected annual production of 11.5 GWh. This project, which has already obtained a twenty-year tariff, is the first full technological renovation of the Group's wind farms abroad. This process will carry on with the recently authorised *repowering* of the Beckendorf wind farm (13 MW). In this country there is also a greenfield wind farm under construction in Aukrug (22 MW), expected to be completed in the first half of 2026.

Paolo Merli, Chief Executive Officer of ERG, commented, *"Thanks to the 40 MW of new wind capacity just awarded by auction and the authorisation obtained for a new repowering project, together with the Reinsdorf wind farm just completed and the Aukrug wind farm under construction, we are giving visibility to around 80 MW of new projects in Germany, all developed internally, in line with our Route-to-Market strategy which involves securing revenues through CFDs."*
