### **ERG confirmed the "A-List" of the Carbon Disclosure Project for the Second Year The Group's has been acknowledged "Leadership" across all analyzed categories**

**Genoa, 6 February 2024** – ERG reaffirms its position on the "A-List" of the CDP (Carbon Disclosure Project) for the second consecutive year. This global non-profit organization monitors performance in climate change management, guiding companies and governments towards reducing greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions.

Based on data collected by the CDP during 2023, ERG remains among the 346 leading global companies committed to fighting climate change (out of over 21,000 evaluated), confirming the effectiveness of the decarbonization strategies implemented by the Group, which has become a pure renewable player over the year.

Specifically, the continued presence on the "A-List" has been determined by the recognition of "Leadership" across all analyzed areas, ranking above the global average (rating C) and the average of companies producing energy from renewable sources (rating B).

Compared to last year, the Group has improved consistently in the climate change risk & opportunity disclosure management and greenhouse gas emission reduction targets approved by the Science Based Target initiative. Further there have been numerous best practices for the Group such as the governance model and the 100% renewable growth strategy.
