Scotland: Creag Riabhach wind farm started up

Genoa, January 12, 2023 - ERG has started up the Creag Riabhach wind farm in the county of Sutherland, in northern Scotland.

ERG has managed the design and construction operations of the wind farm, with a total installed capacity of 92.4 MW (based on 22 4.2 MW Enercon E115 turbines) and an overall production at full capacity of 271 GWh per year, equivalent to the needs of around 67,000 households, avoiding the emission of 125 kt of CO₂ per year.

A large amount of the electricity produced by the wind farm will be covered by a 10-year Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) signed with ENGIE UK Markets Ltd, a company belonging to the ENGIE group.

Paolo Merli, CEO ERG, commented: "The energisation of the Creag Riabhach wind farm marks another important step in the Group's growth in the United Kingdom, where we have increased the installed renewable capacity by around 250 MW during the last year, in line with the targets of our 2022-2026 business plan."
