



### **How was it useful?**

[S. Steen Moeller] I found the aspect of structure more helpful than anything else, how to structure a working group, since group work does not just mean enjoying each other's company. We can't always just think of having fun when working in a group because it is important that, when working as a group, it needs to be efficient and effective even if we don't have.... if we don't always agree etc. So, we need to know the right approach, to give our work a structure, and this course teaches you how to do that.

[E.Karkalaite] I think the most useful thing was giving a name to our talents. It is a little like calling someone by name; when you use the right name, people stop, turn around and respond, so if you give a name to your talent, you will be able to draw on this every time you feel the need. I think that the greatest thing is that, by giving your talent a name, there is no risk that you will ever forget that you possess it.

[F.Cozza] The hardest thing for a leader is giving accurate and balanced feedback, at the right moment. I found it useful to focus on this point, which I believe to be crucial.
